ASHARE Maine Chapter – A synopsis for 50 years and counting!

1. The Beginning

The American Society of Heating, Refrigerating and Air Conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE) have a long history in our country and abroad. It was founded in 1894 in New York City and held annual meetings since 1895 becoming during the years a global organization holding national and international events.

In Maine, ASHRAE started as a local Chapter in 1972.

In the fall of 1971 eight members of this National Society met over dinner to discuss the feasibility of forming a Maine Chapter. Up to that time, the closest Chapter meeting a member could attend was in Boston, MA.

Between the fall of 1971 and the summer of 1972, the Maine contingency grew from eighteen to sixty plus members with a lot of interest for potential growth.

On September 23rd, 1972, two Society officers came to Maine. Mr. Walter Spiegel, the Society's President, and Mr. Bruno Morabito, Regional Chairman, presented the Maine Chapter with its charter.

The Maine Chapter officers who were installed came from a good cross- section of the mechanical engineering field from the State of Maine.

Mr. Daniel W. Vachon, Assistant Director of Electric Space Conditioning at Central Maine Power Company was sworn in as President.

Mr. Albert Milasauskis and Mr. Edward Blaisdell, from A. Harriman Associates, were respectively installed as First and Second Vice Presidents.

Mr. Paul Gardner of Daris Refrigeration of Auburn was elected the Chapter's Secretary.

Mr. Manley Irish of Group Design of Portand was elected Treasurer and Mr. John McHugh of Honeywell was named as Member at Large on the Board of Governors.

As the Chapter had to have a Past President, Mr. John Roman of Higgins, Webster and Partners from Bangor was installed as an Honorary Past President. He acted as an adviser and aide to the Chapter President.

3. Organization

During the years, the Chapter structure with Elected President, Vice- President, Secretary and Treasurer, Past President remained very similar to the original, with a few minor changes.

Task committees were added with designated members for a better organization of the Chapter.

After the 1973-1974 Oil Crisis, Energy Conservation became an important topic in the country that affected most industries including the HVAC and construction.

In the 80's Maine Chapter introduced the Energy Management Committee. The number of Committees was reduced or changed due to the needs of the Chapter:

In 1984, a Chapter Historian was introduced. The first Maine ASHRAE Historian was Mr. Winston W. Phipps.

In 1991 the first Golf Tournament was held in Portland, so in the 90's a separate committee was assigned for this event.

In 2001, with the evolution of digital technology, the Maine Chapter website was introduced. During the years the website evolved and became the main vehicle to inform the members about the Chapter, organize meetings and up-date with all news in the industry. With the introduction of the website, another committee was formed – Webmaster.

4. Annually Meeting Schedule

Maine Chapter meetings start every September and end in June the following year with the Golf Tournament. There are 9 informative meetings with presentations of different topics suggested by the Chapter Board in every session.

5. Maine ASHRAE Chapter and Students Activities

Since the beginning, the Chapter has been involved in bringing student body members from Maine universities, technical institutes and vocational colleges.

The Maine Chapter has now a separate committee for the Student Activities that involves students from University of Maine and Community Colleges from all over the state.

In the last few years, April meetings were designated to the students involved in the Maine Chapter or with special academic achievements. The Chapter recognizes and rewards student's achievements with two Scholarships every year.

In 2018 the Chapter formed the "Youth Maine ASHRAE Chapter" where young engineers and students are encouraged to participate at the meetings.

6. Special Events

In 1992 and in 2006 Maine ASHRAE Chapter was the host of the Region 1 CRC meeting that was held at the Holiday Inn by the Bay in Portland.

The Maine ASHRAE Chapter is one of the most recognizable organizations in the state that gather professionals and personnel from the construction fields related to HVAC and mechanical engineering.

The number of members grew from 68 in 1972 to 189 in our days with potential of expansion.
