Come join Maine ASHRAE YEA (young engineers in ASHRAE) and cheer on the Sea Dogs at Hadlock field.


The tickets for the game will be covered by event sponsor Adrian Clements from Trumbull Campbell Associates. Make sure to RSVP to ensure you get a ticket.
